Bill of Rights of The Grand Republic of Moontonia

- 1. It is hereby recognized and declared that in Moontonia all citizens have the:
 - a. The right to freedom of religion;
 - b. The right of the individual to equality before the law;
 - c. The right of the individual to life, security of the person, and enjoyment of property.
- 2. All citizens of the Moontonia are entitled to:
 - a. Access to a clean and reliable source of water;
 - b. Access to food;
 - c. Access to shelter.
- 3. All citizens of the Moontonia shall be given the means to stay safe and protected from danger, whether that be protection by self or military.
- 4. All inhabitants of the Moontonia when in court, are entitled to an attorney. If they do not have one, the state will provide them with one.
- 5. All convicted citizens have the right to bail unless The Cabinet or Supreme Leader say otherwise. The court possesses the right to determine the bail.
- 6. All Senate and Cabinet members when in debate, have the right to:
 - a. Speak freely about topics pertaining to the debate.
- 7. All Senate and Cabinet members are exempt from:
 - a. Taxation;
 - b. Imprisonment or exile without a trial;
 - c. The requirement to accept a duel;
 - d. Banned media, goods, or services.
- 8. The Cabinet reserves the right to edit, change, or add to this bill.
